"Clinton County Continues to Offer Free H1N1 Flu Immunization Clinics" January 27, 2010

Public Health officials continue to stress the importance of individuals being vaccinated against H1N1 flu. The vaccine is now available in ample supply for anyone in the community who wants protection from H1N1. The number of public clinics has increased as vaccine supply has become available. The H1N1 vaccination is **FREE**. Please dress for easy access to your upper arm if you will be attending an H1N1 clinic.

The Clinton County Health Department continues to closely monitor illness in the community for influenza type illness in schools, work sites and those presenting to the local CVPH Emergency Department. While influenza type illness is not currently widespread in our community officials expect H1N1 and seasonal flu to stay in our area well into the spring, possibly as late as March/April. Take steps today to protect yourself, family, co-workers and friends against H1N1 influenza.
