The Clinton County Health Department will be hosting a **pediatric wellness** event for **children birth-5 years of age on Thursday, April 29, 2010 at the Town of Black Brook Offices in AuSable Forks.** The event will start at **10:00 am and run until 12 noon.** Lead screening, child immunizations and children's dental health supplies will be available at no cost. If you think your child needs immunizations, please bring his/her current vaccination record. Information will also be available about healthy eating, reading and motor development.

The Healthy Neighborhoods Program will be available to answer questions and make appointments. Their program conducts a short at home survey to identify potential safety and environmental health issues. If issues are identified, the family may be program eligible to receive free safety items. Some of the items are smoke detectors, CO detectors, baby safety gates, etc. There will also be a family fun activity table with Family Connections and a book for each child attending!
