The Clinton County Health Department will be offering one **last public flu clinic** on **Wednesday, December 13th from 10:00am until 1:00pm** at the **Old Court House 2nd floor meeting room, 133 Margaret Street Plattsburgh**. Influenza disease typically peaks in February and can circulate through April. Getting vaccinated now still makes sense. It is not too late.

Each year in the US, between 5 and 20 percent of the population is infected with influenza. In addition, 36,000 deaths are attributed to influenza and on average 200,000 people are hospitalized due to influenza complications. Protect yourself and your loved ones; receive an influenza immunization. Pneumococcal vaccine is also available for those who are eligible.
