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## Clinton County Health Department Press Release "Seasonal Flu Clinic in Clinton County" December 28, 2009

The Clinton County Health Department will be offering a seasonal flu and H1N1 vaccination clinic for Clinton County residents. Pneumonia vaccine will also be available.

**When:** Wednesday, Dec. 30, 2009 10:00am – 1:00pm  
**Where:** Government Center First Floor Meeting Room  
(Please use the back entrance)

The seasonal vaccine will be offered for all Clinton County residents. Those people that fall in "high risk" groups are strongly encouraged to be vaccinated against seasonal influenza. These groups include people with underlying health conditions like, asthma, diabetes, heart conditions, etc.

The cost for this vaccine is as follows:

- **Medicaid accepted (you must bring your card)**
- **Medicare Part B accepted (you must bring your card)**
- **\$30.00 for influenza vaccine (shot or mist)**
- **\$45 for Pneumonia Vaccine**
- **No cost for children aged 18 and under. Must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.**
- **\$10.00 per shot if you have HEAP, WIC (Enrolled Pregnant Women), or receive Food Stamps.**

There is **NO CHARGE** for the H1N1 vaccine. Both nasal mist and injectable (shot) vaccine will be available. This vaccine is open to the general public. There are no longer any health eligibility requirements to receive this vaccination.
