

We understand that guidance and information related to COVID-19 testing changes often and can be confusing. Please know the health and safety of Clinton County residents is Clinton County Health Department's (CCHD) number one priority at all times. CCHD will continue to update our guidance regularly and work with local providers to keep an accurate listing of COVID-19 testing sites.

Who should get tested for current infection?

- People who have symptoms of COVID-19.
- People who have had a known exposure to someone with suspected or confirmed COVID-19.
 - People who are fully vaccinated should get tested 3-5 days after exposure, and wear a mask in public indoor settings for 14 days or until they receive a negative test result.
 - People who are not fully vaccinated should quarantine and be tested immediately after being identified, and, if negative, tested again in 5–7 days after last exposure or immediately if symptoms develop during quarantine.
- People who are prioritized for community screening for COVID-19.
- People not fully vaccinated with COVID-19 vaccine who have been asked or referred to get testing by their school, workplace, healthcare provider, state, tribal, local or territorial health department.

Anyone with any signs or symptoms of COVID-19 should get tested, regardless of vaccination status or prior infection. If you get tested because you have symptoms or were potentially exposed to the virus, you should stay away from others while you wait for your test results. Follow the advice of your health care provider or a public health professional.

How do I get tested for current COVID-19 infection?

- Symptomatic individuals (those who have one or more symptom of COVID-19) should be under the care of a medical professional.
 - Individuals should contact their primary care provider to seek testing.
 - Individuals who do not have a primary care provider should contact a local Urgi-Care center or hospital.
- Asymptomatic individuals (those without symptoms) who are seeking testing due to an exposure to COVID-19 should contact their healthcare provider, local pharmacy, or Urgi-Care center for testing.
- Individuals who do not have health insurance and/or a primary care provider can contact CCHD for testing assistance at 518-565-4848.
